Come join us on Wednesday September 9th for an important and educational program. Eric Lemelson of Lemelson Vineyards will share with us his passion for environmental concerns as they apply to the wine industry. What do terms such as “organic” and “salmon safe” mean? Why should they be of importance to wineries – and to us as consumers?

In addition, of course, we’ll be sampling some of Lemelson’s beautiful wines. Located in Carlton, OR, the heart of Oregon’s Pinot Noir grape country, Lemelson Vineyards has made quality the focus of its wine making process. Lemelson Vineyards believes in growing grapes organically and farming the land in a sustainable way in harmony with the environment. We will be sampling the following estate wines:

- 1) 2007 Dry Riesling
- 2) 2006 Reserve Chardonnay
- 3) 2007 Thea’s Selection Pinot Noir
- 4) 2007 Meyer Vineyard Pinot Noir
- 5) 2006 Jerome Reserve Pinot Noir

As usual, there will also be a welcome wine from the CWES cellar, and chefs JD Thomas and Michael Amore have created exceptional food bites specifically to match with these wines.

Join us for the Welcome Wine at 7:15 PM and the Program to begin at 7:30 PM. Bring 2 (two) wine glasses for comparative tasting.
